

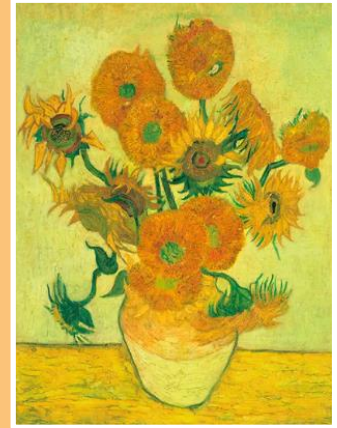
How to enjoy the exhibition “Van Gogh and Still Life”

Born in 1977. Graduated from the College of Arts and Sciences, University of Tokyo. Studied abroad at KU Leuven, a Catholic research university in Belgium. Associate professor at Shokei Gakuin University. Member of JNS. Member of the Japan Art History Society and the Société franco-japonaise d'art et d'archéologie. He participated in Van Gogh's field research in Europe, thoroughly exploring the areas where Gogh lived, places where Gogh painted, and related museums.
