She has more than 15 years of experience teaching children of Japanese families living in the Netherlands and children of international marriages in supplementary schools in The Hague and Rotterdam, as well as in Japanese language classes. She regularly gives lectures on Dutch education at events sponsored by the Embassy of the Kingdom of the Netherlands in Tokyo. She is the author of several Japanese language textbooks.
