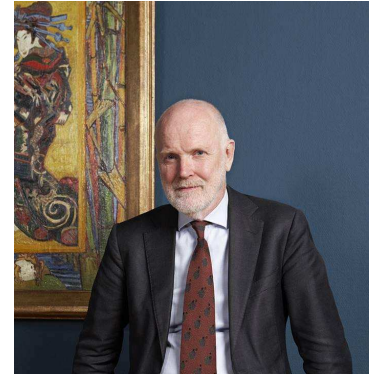


## “Van Gogh and Japan”
